#### NOTICE TO IMPORTERS

Importers are hereby notified that

1. Consequent on the issue of Government Notices No. 1309 and 1310 dated 11th December, 1975, issued by the Ministry of Trade and Industry, the Notice dated 17th November, 1975, issued by the Bank of Sierra Leone is hereby rescinded and replaced by the following.

2. Applications for payment for goods imported under Specific Import Licences issued in 1976 should be forwarded to the commercial banks who will either remit the amounts under their authority or forward the applications to the Bank of Sierra Leone.

3. Applications for payment for goods imported under the Open General Licence should also be forwarded to the importers' bankers together with supporting documentary evidence, i.e. a schedule with supporting invoices and customs entries, showing the actual level of imports of these goods received by them in 1975, before orders are placed.

4. Payments for importation of goods based on 1975 Specific Import Licences may not be allowed, if the goods were shipped after 31st December, 1975, unless the licences have been extended by the Ministry of Trade and Industry beyond December 31, 1975. Similarly, payments for goods under the 1975 Open General Licence may not be allowed if the goods were shipped after 31st January, 1976.

5. All orders for goods above Le5,000 under Open General Licence must be referred to the Bank of Sierra Leone together with supporting *pro-forma* invoices indicating the payment terms and approval obtained before the orders are placed.

6. New regulations governing payments for imports have been issued to cover imports of goods shipped as from the date of this Notice under Specific Import Licences and the Open General Licence among which are:—

(i) All applications to remit payments for imports should be on an Exchange Control Form A1 and should state, among other details required on the form,

(a) The S.I.T.C. Code Number

(b) The Specific Import Licence Number (if applicable).

(ii) Since procurement through buying agents tends to be unnecessarily expensive to Sierra Leone in terms of foreign exchange, importers are advised to make their purchases direct from the manufacturers or suppliers in the country of origin of the goods. Consequently, buying commission may no longer be allowed unless it is proved to be absolutely necessary.

(iii) Procurements of credit through overseas confirming houses are also expensive; financing commission and other such bank charges may, therefore, not be allowed. Payment of interest will only be allowed on usance bills.

(iv) Importers are advised to negotiate with their suppliers, prices consistent with those ruling in the country of export for the quality and quantity of the goods being imported.

(v) No attempt should be made by the suppliers to build into the selling price of goods, buying commission and/or financial charges.

(vi) Unnecessary air freighting of goods in commercial quantities should not be undertaken.

7. Importers are advised to contact their bankers who will notify them in detail of the current procedures governing applications to purchase foreign currency for goods imported under Specific Import Licences and under the Open General Licence.

LOTTERY TICKETS)1. *Application of the Programme*

This programme provides for a Republic Anniversary Special Draw which will be held on the 4th May, 1976 and shall be referred to hereinafter as the "Republic Anniversary Special Draw". Also this programme provides for an Ordinary Draw which will be held on the 18th May, 1976 and shall be referred to hereinafter as the "Mid-Month Draw" and which will be performed in the manner and under the conditions specified below:—

2. *The Lottery tickets for the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws*

(a) For the Republic Anniversary Special Draw specified in this programme, the State Lottery shall issue 50,000 tickets to bearer (hereinafter referred to as tickets). The tickets to be issued for any of the series mentioned in Section 1 above will be marked in the places (on the face of each ticket) with serial numbers DD 000001 to DD 050000 inclusive. The tickets will also be marked with the words "Republic Anniversary Special Draw" to denote the draw in which the tickets are to participate.

(b) For the Mid-Month Draw specified in this programme, the State Lottery shall issue 50,000 tickets to bearer (hereinafter referred to as tickets). The tickets issued for any of the series mentioned in Section 1 above will be marked in the places (on the face of each ticket) with serial numbers E 000001 to E 050000 inclusive. The tickets will be marked with the words "Mid-Month Draw" also with the series numbers of the draw in which the tickets are to participate.

(c) In the programme a reference to a serial number shall be deemed to include a reference to any letter printed immediately before the digits forming the said serial number.

3. *Participation in the draws*

(a) All tickets issued for the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws specified in this programme will participate subject to the conditions specified in this programme. A separate draw will be held for each series.

(b) Notwithstanding anything contained in this section 3, a ticket issued by the State Lottery under section 2 hereof shall not participate in the draw if either the serial number on the face of the ticket (in either of the places where that number is marked) or the series numbers or any digit or part of a digit, are not printed thereon, or are not properly printed or printed in such a manner that it is not possible to verify such numbers or digits on the face of the tickets.

(c) The holder of a ticket on which the serial number of the ticket or the series number of the draw is not printed or is not properly printed or is printed in such a manner that it cannot be verified as stated in paragraph (b) of this section, shall be entitled to receive from the State Lottery only the nominal price of the ticket as stated thereon. Such ticket shall not entitle its holder to any right whatsoever other than the aforesaid right to receive the nominal price and in particular such ticket shall not entitle its holder to any compensation whatsoever for not including such ticket in the draw, or for any other reason.

4. *The sale of tickets and their price*

(a) The ticket shall be sold by the State Lottery directly and/or through selling agents or sellers appointed by the above-mentioned agents.

(b) The price of each ticket shall be:—

Mid-Month Draw	—	25 cents

5. *Marking of tickets with the name and address of the Agent*

The Selling agent shall upon the sale of any ticket (either by him directly or through his sub-agent or seller stamp it with a stamp bearing the name and address of such agents.

6. *The prices of the Republic Anniversary Special Draw*

(a) In the Republic Anniversary Special Draw of the series specified in this programme 5,477 numbers (out of 50,000) corresponding to the numbers on the issued tickets will be drawn in five stages in which the total prizes shall amount to Le9,780.

(b) Two Consolation prizes of Le20 will be paid to the holders of the ticket the serial number of which are less by one or greater by one than the serial number of the ticket drawn under item (6a) of the sixth stage that wins first prize of Le1,000. 7. *The making of the draw and the control thereof*

The draws will be made by the State Lottery and under its instructions. The draws will be made in public at the place and at the time to be specified in a public notice that will be published in the daily press.

8. *Deferment of the draws*

In the event of the State Lottery being unable due to circumstances over which it has no control to hold the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws or part thereof under this programme, such draws or part thereof shall be held at a place and time specified in a notice issued to the public by the State Lottery.

9. *Lottery Machine*

(a) For making the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws under this programme, the State Lottery shall use, of its discretion from time to time—

- (i) The (Five) rotary machines as specified in Section 10 herein or
- (ii) The projecting machine as specified in section 11 herein.

(b) For making the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws under this programme, the State Lottery shall use, as addition to the Machines as mentioned in paragraph (a) above, an additional Lottery box in the form of a draw hereinafter referred to as "Prize Box".

(c) In the said draw the machine and prize box specified above shall be operated in accordance with instructions given by the representative of the State Lottery present at the draw.

10. *Rotary Machine—Manner of use*

(a) The five rotary machines shall be marked consecutively with letters A, B, C, D and E.

(b) Before the making of the draws under this programme, the balls as specified below shall be inserted in each of the rotary machines:—

- (1) In machine A—ten balls marked consecutively with digits 0 to 9 inclusive.
- (2) In machine B—ten balls marked consecutively with digits 0 to 9 inclusive.
- (3) In machine C—ten balls marked consecutively with digits 0 to 9 inclusive.
- (4) In machine D—ten balls marked consecutively with digits 0 to 9 inclusive.
- (5) In machine E—five balls marked consecutively with digits 0 to 4 inclusive.

(c) Every ball of the said balls bearing digit 6 or 9 as the case may be shall be marked with an additional sign, i.e. a horizontal line drawn under the digit on the ball referred to above.

11. *Projecting Machine—Manner of use*

(a) The projecting machine—which was manufactured for the State Lottery by the Royal Institute for International Research in Norway, shall consist of wheels on which digits as specified below are engraved. The machine shall consist of a device for the projection of the digits on the wheels as specified, in such a manner that not more than one digit on any wheel of the machine shall be projected at a time.

(b) In order to execute the draw in its following stages, i.e. first, second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth stages, five wheels are to be inserted in the machine No. 1 and shall be marked consecutively with letters A, B, C, D and E as follows:—

- (1) Wheel 'A' on which digits 0 to 9 inclusive are engraved.
- (2) Wheel 'B' on which digits 0 to 9 inclusive are engraved.
- (3) Wheel 'C' on which digits 0 to 9 inclusive are engraved.
- (4) Wheel 'D' on which digits 0 to 9 inclusive are engraved.
- (5) Wheel 'E' on which digits 0 to 4 inclusive are engraved.

12. *The preparation of the 'Prize Box' for the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws*

Before making the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws under this programme a number of cards equivalent to the number of the tickets that will be drawn at the Fifth stages of the draws will be deposited in the prizes box. On each such card there will be printed a sum equal to the amount of one of the prizes specified for the said stages of the draws in accordance with sections 6 and 6A of this programme.

13. *The Manner in which the draw of the tickets for the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month draws shall be made under section 6 and 6A (a) by the rotary machine as specified in section 3*

(a) The winning numbers of the first stage of the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month draws shall be drawn by the picking up of one ball only from the rotary machine marked 'A' and the coming up of this ball shall be deemed to constitute the drawing at this stage, of all the tickets of the series the serial number of which end with the digit marked on the ball as drawn from the machine marked 'A'.



- (b) The winning numbers of the second stage of the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month Draws shall be drawn by picking up the ball as specified in paragraph (a) above and before commencing the draw of the second stage of the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month draws, the ball ejected from machine 'A' is re-inserted into the machine and ten balls marked consecutively with digits from 0 to 9 inclusive shall be deposited in machine marked 'B'.
- (c) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (b) the draw of the numbers corresponding to the second stage of the Republic Anniversary Special Draw shall be held by picking up three balls, the first ball from machine 'A' the second ball from machine 'B' and the third ball from machine 'C' to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the three digits marked on the balls picked up as aforesaid.
- (d) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (b) the draw of the numbers corresponding to the second stage of the Mid-Month draw shall be held by picking up two balls, the first ball from machine 'A' and the second ball from machine 'B' to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the two digits marked on the balls picked up as aforesaid.
- (e) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (c) the draw of the numbers corresponding to the third and fourth stages of the Republic Anniversary Special Draw shall be held separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said third stage and immediately afterwards—separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said fourth stage; i.e. by picking up three and four balls respectively; the first ball from machine A, the second—from machine B, the third—from machine C and the fourth—from machine D, and the coming up of these three and four balls shall be deemed with respect to the relevant items of the third and fourth stages as the case may be, to constitute the drawing of all the tickets the serial numbers of which end with the digit marked on the ball picked up as aforesaid that is the digit marked on the ball drawn from the machine 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit marked on the ball drawn from the machine 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial numbers the digit marked on the ball drawn from the machine 'C' shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'D' shall be deemed to be the fourth digit from the right side of the said serial numbers.
- (f) After the completion of the draws of each item of the third and fourth stages of the Republic Anniversary Special Draw, the balls that were picked up from each rotary machine marked A, B, C, and D shall be returned to the machines from which they were removed before commencing the draws for the next stage.
- (g) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (d) the draw of the numbers corresponding to the third, fourth and fifth stages of the Mid-Month Draw shall be held separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said third stage and immediately afterwards—separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said fourth stage and immediately afterwards separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said fifth stage; i.e. by picking up three and four balls respectively; the first ball from machine A, the second from machine B, the third from machine C and the fourth from machine D, and the coming up of these three and four balls shall be deemed with respect to the relevant items of the third, fourth and fifth stages as the case may be, to constitute the drawing of all the tickets the serial numbers of which end with the digit marked on the ball picked up as aforesaid; that is the digit marked on the ball drawn from the machine 'A' shall be deemed to be the digit marked on the ball drawn from the machine 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit marked on the ball drawn from the machine 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial numbers the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'C' shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'D' shall be deemed to be the fourth digit from the right side of the said serial numbers.
- (h) After the completion of the draws of each item of the third, fourth and fifth stages of the Mid-Month draw, the balls that were picked up from each rotary machine marked A, B, C and D shall be returned to the machine from which they were removed before commencing the draws for the next stage.
- (i) The draw of the numbers of the fifth stage of the Republic Anniversary Special and the draw of the numbers of the sixth stage of the Mid-Month draw shall be made (separately for each number which has to be drawn in accordance with the items enumerated for this stage) by the picking up of one ball only from each of the rotary machines marked A, B, C, D and E and the picking up simultaneously of one card only from the 'prize box'. The coming up of the five balls only from each of the rotary machines marked A, B, C, D and E shall be deemed to be the draw of the tickets bearing the serial number conforming to the number formed by the digits marked on the five balls in such a way that the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the serial number of the said ticket and the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial number and that the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'C' shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'D' shall be deemed to be the fourth digit from the right side of the said serial number and that the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine 'E' shall be deemed to be the fifth digit from the right side of the said serial number. The amount marked on the card drawn simultaneously from the prizes box as aforesaid.
- (j) After the picking up of the balls as specified in paragraph (i) above the ball drawn from each of the machines marked A, B, C, D and E as aforesaid shall be returned to the machines from which it was drawn before beginning the draw for the next item of the stage.
- (k) Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph (j) above, in the event that the balls drawn in accordance with the said paragraph from machine A, B, C, D and E all bear the digit '0' it shall be deemed that the ticket bearing number 050000 was drawn in accordance with that paragraph.
- (l) Notwithstanding anything contained in this section 13 in the event of more than one ball being picked up from any of the machines A, B, C, D and E at the making of the draws specified in this programme including the separate draw of tickets at the fifth and sixth stages, the picking up of all balls for this item of the stage of the draws in question shall be null and void and all balls so drawn shall be returned into the machine from which they were drawn and the draw for this item shall be recommenced from the beginning.

- machine No. 1 and the digit that will be projected from the wheel marked 'A' shall be deemed to constitute the drawing at this stage, of all the tickets of that series, the serial numbers of which end with the digit projected from wheel 'A'.
- (b) Immediately after the projection of the digit as specified in paragraph (a) above, the machine No. 1 shall be removed from the projecting machine and substituted by machine No. 2 with its set of five wheels marked with letters 'A' to 'E' will be engraved with digits 0 to 4 and others 0 to 9.
- (c) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (b) above, the draw of the numbers corresponding to the second stage of the Republic Anniversary Special draw shall be held by the employment of wheels, A, B, and C only of the projecting machine and the three digits that will be projected from the wheels A, B, and C shall be deemed to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the three digits projected as aforesaid, that is the digit projected from wheel 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'C' shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number.
- (d) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (b) above, the draw of the numbers corresponding to the second stage of the Mid-Month draw shall be held by the employment of wheels, A and B only of the projecting machine and the two digits that will be projected from the wheels A and B shall be deemed to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the two digits projected as aforesaid this is the digit projected from wheel 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial number.
- (e) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (c) above the draw of the numbers corresponding to the third and fourth stages of the Republic Anniversary Special Draw shall be held separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said third stage and immediately afterwards separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said fourth stage; by the employment of wheels A, B, C and D only of the projecting machine and the three and four digits that will be projected from the third and fourth stages as the case may be, to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the three and four digits that will be projected from the wheels A, B, C and D and shall be deemed with respect to relevant items of the third and fourth stages as the case may be, to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the three and four digits projected as aforesaid, that is the digit projected from wheel 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'C' shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'D' shall be deemed to be the fourth digit from the right side of the said serial numbers.
- (f) On completion of the operation prescribed in paragraph (d) above the draw of the numbers corresponding to the third, fourth and fifth stages of the Mid-Month draw shall be held separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said third stage and immediately afterwards separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said fourth stage and immediately afterwards separately for each item of the items enumerated in the said fifth stage; by the employment of wheels A, B, C and D only of the projecting machine and the three and four digits that will be projected from the wheels A, B, C and D shall be deemed with respect to the relevant items of the third, fourth and fifth stages as the case may be, to constitute the drawing of all tickets the serial numbers of which end with the three and four digits projected as aforesaid, that is the digit projected from wheel 'A' shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'B' shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'C' shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number and the digit projected from wheel 'D' shall be deemed to be the fourth digit from the right side of the said serial numbers.
- (g) After the completion of the draws of each item of the third and fourth stages of the Republic Anniversary Special Draw prescribed in paragraph (e) above, and after the completion of the draws of each item of the third, fourth and fifth stages of the Mid-Month draw prescribed in paragraph (f) above, the draw of the numbers of the fifth stage of the Republic Anniversary Special draw and the draw of the numbers of the sixth stage of the Mid-Month draw shall be made separately for each number which has to be drawn in accordance with all the wheels A, B, C, D and E and the picking up simultaneously of one card from the 'prize box'. The coming up of the five balls one only from each of the rotary machines marked A, B, C, D and E shall be deemed to be the draw of the tickets bearing the serial number conforming to the number formed by the digits marked on the five balls in such a way that the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine A shall be deemed to be the first digit from the right side of the serial number of the said ticket and the digit marked on the ball drawn from machine B shall be deemed to be the second digit from the right side of the said serial number and that the digit projected from wheel C shall be deemed to be the third digit from the right side of the said serial number and that the digit projected from wheel D shall be deemed to be the fourth digit from the right side of the said serial number and that the digit projected from wheel E shall be deemed to be the fifth digit from the right side of the said serial number. The amount marked on the card drawn simultaneously from the prizes box as aforesaid.
- (h) Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph (g) above in the event that all the digits projected from the wheels A, B, C, D and E shall be '0' it shall be deemed that the ticket bearing serial number 050000 was drawn in accordance with that paragraph.
- (i) Notwithstanding anything contained in this section 14 in the event of a number being unclearly projected on a digit or digits of such number shall be missing, at any time of any stage of the stages of the draws specified in the programme including the separate draw of tickets at the fifth and sixth stages, such projection shall be null and void and the projecting machine shall be re-employed for the making of the draw of this item.
- (j) The provision of this section 14 shall not apply in the event of State Lottery deciding under section 9 (a) hereof to use the rotary machine referred to in sub-paragraph (i) thereof.
15. *The recording and publication of the results of the draw.*
- (a) The number of each ticket drawn and the prizes appertaining thereto shall be recorded in a written statement at the conclusion of the Republic Anniversary Special and Mid-Month draws under this programme and such statement shall be signed by the representative of the State Lottery present at the time of the draw and only such statement shall bind the State Lottery.
- (b) The results of the draw shall be published as soon as possible in a special notice to be issued by the State Lottery.
- (c) The holders of tickets shall check the numbers of their tickets against the list of numbers published in the said notice, in order to verify whether the numbers of their tickets correspond with the winning numbers.
16. *The payment of prizes*
- (a) The payment of the amount of the prize to the bearer of the ticket whose number is drawn at the Republic, Anniversary Special and Mid-Month draws specified in this programme shall be made upon the bearer's request and against presentation and surrender of the ticket as from the third day after the holding of the draw in which the winning ticket was drawn but not later than



180 days from the date of the draw. Payment of prizes shall be effected at the time and place specified in the public notice announcing the results of the draw which shall be published by the State Lottery as aforesaid.

- (b) The State Lottery shall not be obliged to pay the prize if it was not claimed as provided in paragraph (a) above.
- (c) The State Lottery shall not be obliged to pay the prize for a ticket the number of which was drawn in the draw if such ticket is lost, destroyed, or obliterated or torn or cut or holed or its serial number or the series number of the draw in which it participated is not sufficiently clear at the time the ticket is presented for payment.
- (d) Notwithstanding anything contained in this section 16, if the Managing Director of the State Lottery has reason to believe that a ticket presented for payment has been lost or stolen, payment of any prize to which the bearer would be entitled under this programme, may be withheld for a reasonable period in order to permit any person who claims that he has a better right to the ticket than the bearer to institute legal action and if such person initiates any such action within the said period the State Lottery shall withhold payment until the matter has been finally decided by a competent Court.

17. *Income Tax*

The prizes are not liable to income tax.

18. *Licence to hold the draw*

The draws are held in accordance with the terms of a licence issued under section 3 of the Control of Betting and Lotteries Act, 1962.

19. *The Address of the State Lottery*

In all matter concerning the State Lottery and this programme, application shall be made to the office of the Company at 44, Siaka Stevens Street, Freetown.
