RESULTS FOR LOCAL COUNCIL BYE-ELECTION IN WARD 002, CONSTITUENCY 001, KAILAHUN DISTRICT

Two (2) Political Parties contested the Local Council Bye-Election as follows: The All Peoples Congress (APC) and the Sierra Leone Peoples Party (SLPP).

The results are as follows:
