In exercise of the power conferred on it by Section 33 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991 (Act No. 6 of 1991) and pursuant to the Provision of Section 28 of the Chieftaincy Act, 2009 (Act No. 10 of 2009), the National Electoral Commission (NEC) in collaboration with the Ministry of Local Government and Rural Development (MLGRD) makes the following proclamation.

The period Tuesday 29th January to Saturday 25th May, 2019 is hereby declared as the dates for the Declaration of rights and the conduct of Paramount Chieftaincy Elections in Sierra Leone.

The vacancies occurred as a result of death of the substantive Paramount Chiefs in the respective Chiefdoms.

Qualifications and disqualification for the Chieftaincy Election are found in Sections 8 and 9 of the Chieftency Act, 2009 (Act No. 10 2009) and any other relevant Legislation.
