4. The Sierra Leone Police (SLP) provided adequate security in all polling stations in the said Wards.
5. Political party agents, the Political Parties Registration Commission (PPRC), the Office of National Security (ONS), National Elections Watch (NEW), Civil Society Network (CSN), Sierra Leone Association of Journalists (SLAJ), WANEP, NMJD observed the Local Council bye- elections on polling day and the tallying of results at the NEC District Offices in Kono and Kambia Districts, respectively.
6.
