Act No. 3 of 2021 entitled—The Independent Commission for Peace and National Cohesion Act, 2020—Being an Act to provide for the establishment of the Independent Commission for Peace and National Cohesion; to confer on the Commission the power to take measures to prevent, manage and resolve conflicts; to build, promote and maintain sustainable peace in Sierra Leone; and to provide for other related matters.

THE HIGH COURT (APPOINTMENT OF CRIMINAL SESSIONS) ORDER, 2020




