I trust that you will see your duties as a service to Sierra Leone and perform them in accordance with the relevant legislation, with dedication, honesty and integrity, in a transparent and credible manner, without bias or favour to any candidate or political party.

At the conclusion of the said bye-election, you must send certified copies of the results obtained by each candidate to me (The National Returning Officer), through your respective Regional Returning Officer (i.e. your Regional Electoral Commissioner), as soon as possible, in accordance with Section 94(1) of the aforementioned Public Elections Act, 2012 (Act No. 4 of 2012).
